



## 2018 ITS Texas Scholarship for Graduate Study in Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS)

Awards:	The Intelligent Transportation Society of Texas (ITS Texas) is pleased to announce the availability of a non-renewable scholarship for one academic year. Multiple recipients may be chosen at the discretion of the ITS Texas Scholarship Selection Committee based on qualifications and/or interviews of candidates.
Eligible Degree Programs:	A graduate degree (Masters or Ph.D.) program in any ITS-related field, which may include civil/transportation engineering, electrical engineering, systems engineering, computer science, or other eligible fields of study.
Value:	Awards may vary from \$1,000 to \$5,000 and amounts are determined at the sole discretion of the ITS Scholarship Selection Committee and Board of Directors.
Eligibility:	Currently enrolled graduate student at any college or university in the State of Texas.
Conditions:	<p>Selection criteria will be based on demonstrated academic ability, stated career objectives, and supporting letters of reference. To be eligible, candidates must be living in the state of Texas and registered as full-time students in a graduate studies program at a college or university in the State of Texas. This is what you will need to submit to the committee:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Résumé or CV describing academic experience, work experience, participation in professional and/or student chapters of relevant associations, awards, etc.;</li> <li>2. An essay of no more than 300 words indicating career objectives and particular interests in ITS, please indicate how you will contribute to the ITS industry;</li> <li>3. If a first semester graduate student, indicate evidence of acceptance for study in a graduate program at a college or university in the State of Texas;</li> <li>4. Academic transcript showing previous courses taken for all undergraduate and graduate coursework, indicating degrees received. Include cumulative GPA for current degree plan (if at least one semester completed);</li> <li>5. Proposed list of courses and anticipated graduation date for current graduate program;</li> <li>6. Two letters of reference to be sent directly to the ITS Texas Scholarship Selection Committee. References should be confidential assessments of the candidate's academic ability and record, research ability or potential, professional experience, commitment to career, and any other personal attributes which indicate that the candidate is worthy of an award.</li> </ol>

Yes, at minimum please send official transcripts for your current college or university. <i>Copies</i> of transcripts for previously attained degrees are OK.</li> <li>2. Can I gather reference letters and send to the committee directly? No, please have your references send their letters via either email from their own address (preferred) or US mail directly to the addresses above. The committee may directly contact references for questions or clarification. Students should not deliver those references themselves.</li> <li>3. Are international students eligible? Yes, international students may apply.</li> </ol>
