GULF COAST GEM & MINERAL SOCIETY EARTH SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - 2016

1. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded. The student is eligible to make additional applications as long as they are attending college, are enrolled in an Earth Science major, and maintain a minimum 2.75 grade point average.

2. WHO MAY APPLY:

The scholarships are open to junior, senior, and graduate students accepted to or attending Texas A&M University-Kingsville or Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi. This includes Del Mar College students that have been accepted to either of the above named universities.

3. **HOW TO APPLY:**

Application forms may be printed from the society web page, email attachments sent to faculty of the Earth Science Department of the respective college, or by contacting a Gulf Coast Gem & Mineral Society (GCG&MS) board member. The completed application shall be submitted to the Gulf Coast Gem & Mineral Society, P.O. Box 60781, Corpus Christi, TX 78466. In addition to the completed application form, the applicant will attach:

1. A copy of an official transcript request directing the university to forward the transcript to:

- 2. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the institution the applicant is, or will be, attending.
- 3. A one-page essay on why the applicant should be awarded this scholarship.
- 4. Additional sheets the applicant may have used to answer any of the questions on the application.
- 5. The application shall be returned to the GCG&MS on or before July 31, 2016.

4. JUDGING CRITERIA:

The criteria to be judged will include grading on scholarship, financial need, leadership, and original essay.

5. METHOD OF SELECTION:

The completed applications will be given to the GCG&MS Board of Directors for review and judging. Copies of each application, along with all attachments and judging criteria, will be provided to each board member.

6. ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDS:

The GCG&MS President will notify the recipient by letter as soon as the award determination is made. The name of the recipient will appear in the society newsletter "Slabs & Cabs" and will be posted on the Society web site.
