Three Scholarships will be awarded by The Houston Gem and Mineral Society (HGMS) in 2021. The deserving students majoring in Earth Science and entering their third year of study at a university, or transferring to a four-year curriculum from a two-year college, will receive a first-place award of \$2500, or a second-place award of \$1000. These scholarships are funded annually by HGMS. An additional award of \$750 is available for the 2021 year, which has been granted by a generous donor.

HGMS is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to study in the areas of Earth Science and related fields and arts, and is the largest such organization in Texas. A major focus of the HGMS is education, accomplished through classes and workshops offered at the clubhouse, through monthly meetings via our eight Sections, and also through our scholarship fund.

HGMS contacts those universities and colleges whose students could qualify for our scholarship. Please disseminate this information through your institution's academic and financial aid departments.
